None. This is an informational update on Metro activities by Metro Councilor Carlotta Collette.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Metro Councilor Carlotta Collette has asked to meet with and brief the Board of Commissioners to share an update on Metro activities.

Metro is the directly elected regional government that serves more than 1.5 million residents in Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties, and the 25 cities in the Portland, Oregon, metropolitan area. The Metro Council includes a council president elected regionwide and six councilors elected by district. Metro also has an auditor who is elected regionwide.

Metro's responsibilities include urban growth boundary management, transportation planning, waste disposal planning and management, operating the zoo, solid waste management and recycling, preservation of natural areas, long-range planning, habitat restoration, and venues for conventions, exhibits, and performing arts.

Metro Councilor Carlotta Collette represents District 2, which includes the cities of Gladstone, Johnson City, Lake Oswego, Milwaukie, Oregon City, Rivergrove, West Linn, a portion of Southwest Portland and unincorporated parts of Clackamas County.
