CITIZEN CONCERNS:

Intersection Boring- SE Haley Rd & 282nd Rd- is a higher crash locations. Plan in place, Christian to have more detail next meeting.

40 mph speed sign on Redland Road up near Springwater. This is not a legal sign and has been taken down.

OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- a. Monthly/YTD fatal crash update: 5 fatalities in August and September. This year 25 crashes and 26 fatalities which is tracking with previous years.
- b. Traffic Volume impacts of COVID 19 Shutdown: 10% below average for this time of the year.
- c. Nomination of TSC Representative to CRFAC: Nathan gave a brief overview of the CRFAC. Members voted unanimously to reappoint Nathan.

- d. Radar speed sign: 3-4 weeks for placement of sign to be placed west bound on Sunnyside road west of 147th. Two lanes of traffic is a concern that it is on the left side but will give it a try.
- e. Check in on menu of opportunities: Revisit next meeting.
- f. Marketing and outreach: Rough draft is out for review. Market testing with teenagers to do some live testing prior to rolling it out.
