RE: American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) Request Form and Process

DATE: March 17, 2022

As instructed by the BCC the ARPA Workgroup has prepared a Request Form (attached). The format of the form will assist the ARPA Workgroup in determining if the project is eligible under the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Final Rule, which can be found here: https://home.treasury.gov/system/files/136/SLFRF-Final-Rule.pdf.

The Request Form will be provided to those that have requested dollars in the past, except for those that have been approved by the BCC, and for any new request. The process of the Request Form is necessary now that the Final Rule is in place and there is a great deal of competition for the remaining dollars. Since the Final Rule was published there have been more requests for ARPA dollars.

The ARPA Workgroup suggests that the deadline for all request by June 3, 2022. No formal requests for the ARPA dollars will be taken after this date in order for the BCC to consider all requests without interruption of new requests to consider. If there are dollars that later need to be redirected because of underspending the requests can be considered again or the Workgroup may be directed to change the process to include new requests.

The Request Form will be posted on the County's website and will be promoted through County Commissioners and County programs and outside organizations. Businesses and non-profits/CBOs will be guided through an alternate process for the ARPA dollars approved for those entities. Both processes are well underway.

The BCC will receive a list of requests that are eligible for ARPA dollars, a copy of the Request Form and criteria applied by the Workgroup to include:

- Direct benefit to Clackamas County communities
- Impact to populations hardest hit by COVID
- Support related to five Clackamas County Goals
- Sticks and Bricks that Support Qualified Census Track
- Sticks and Bricks that Support mid- to low-income housing
- Consideration regarding previous recipients of ARPA or CARES funding
- Plan for sustainability (for on-going programs)

Approvals needed:

- Request Form deadline of June 3, 2022
- General Request form process:
 - o ARPA Workgroup Review for eligibility.
 - o BCC will receive list of those eligibility (summary) and a copy of application.
 - Criteria will be noted on the summary list for BCC.
 - BCC determine final approvals for ARPA dollars.
 - Department of Finance will work with approved organizations for final application and risk assessment process for final approval and funding agreement.
