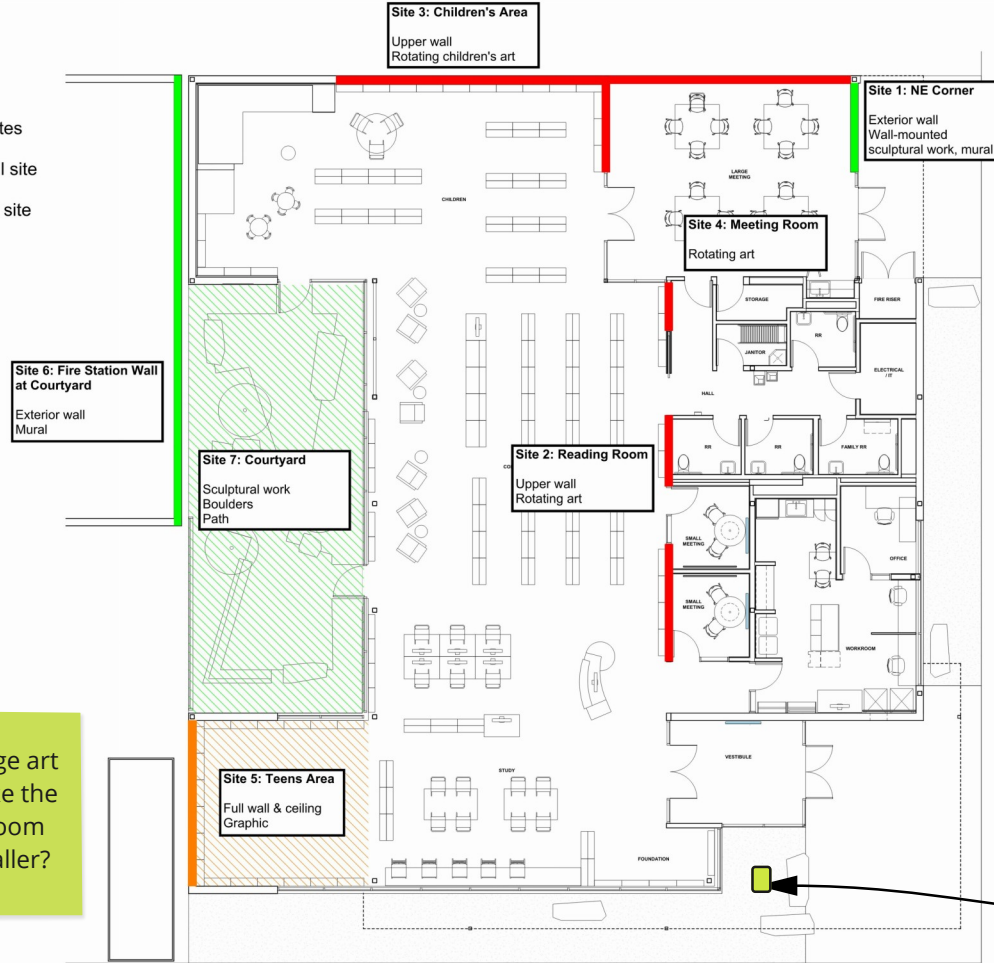

artist in residency/ teen / school partnership opportunities?

is there a place for seasonal art/ decorating? - where would they store the decorations?

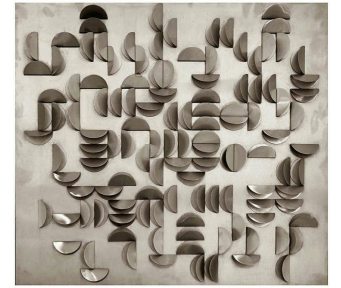
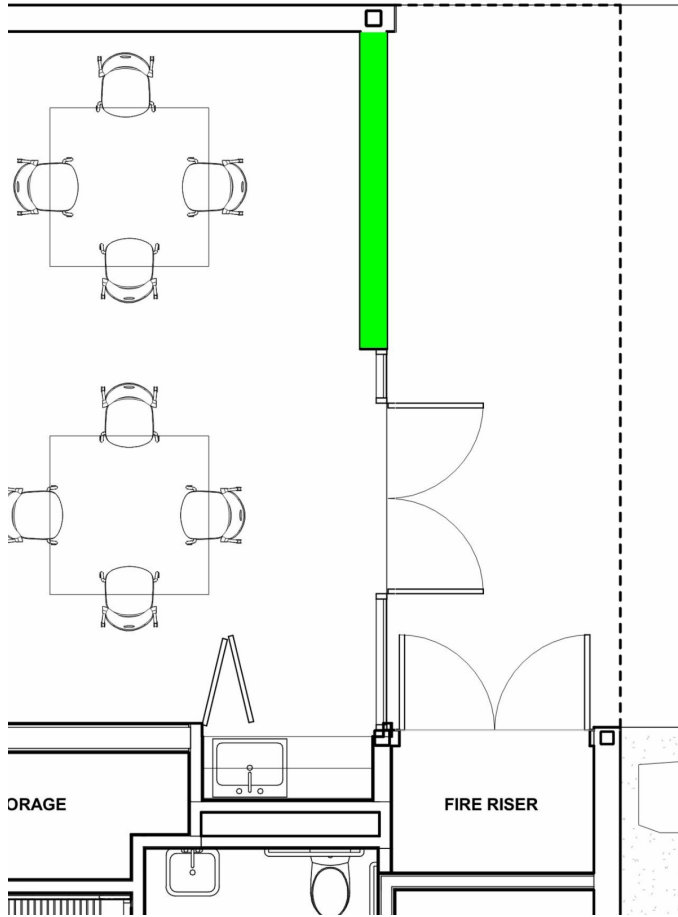
opportunities for posting public events?

a lot of community members seem interested in a sculpture in this location

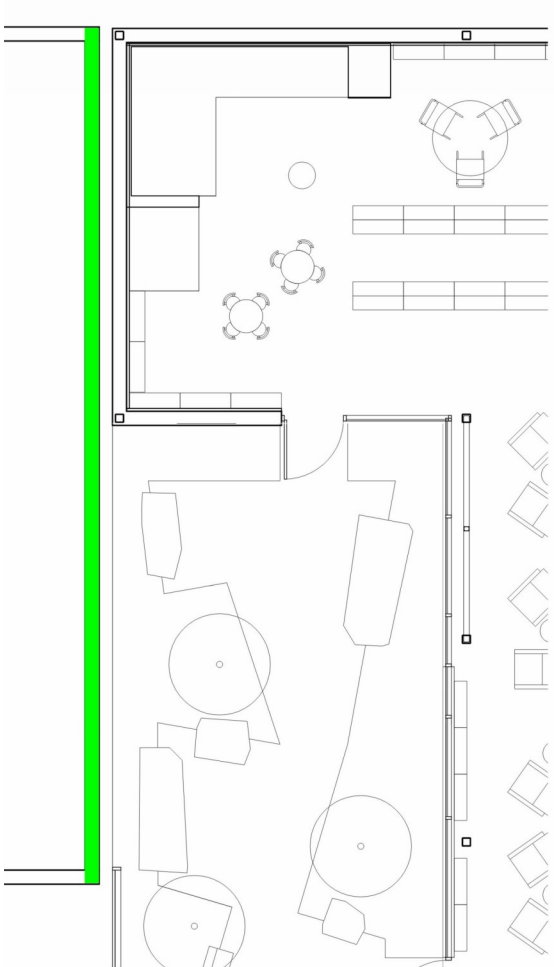

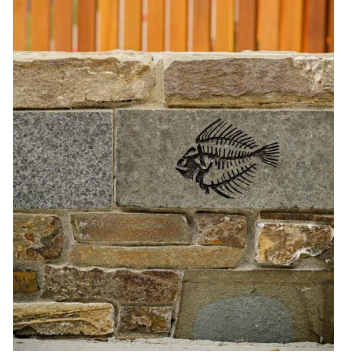
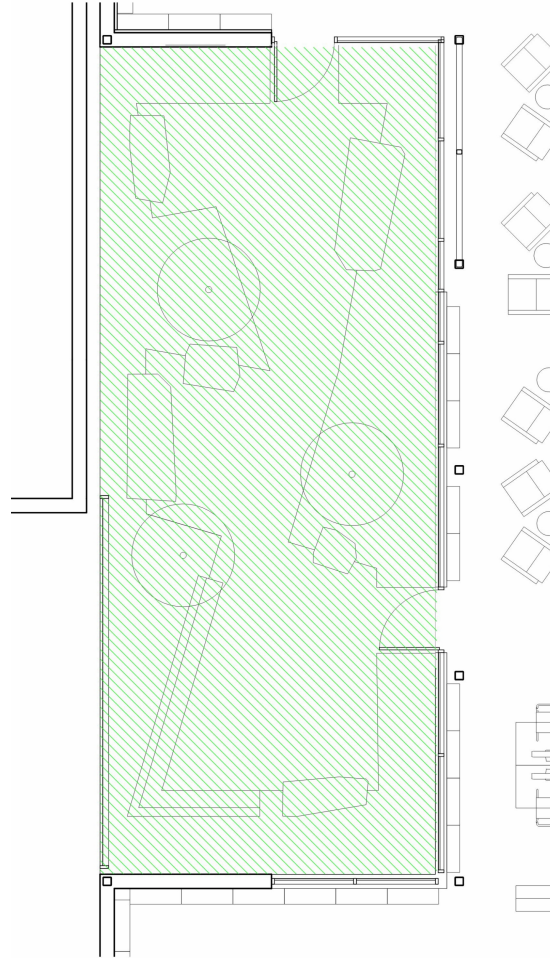
donor bricks -

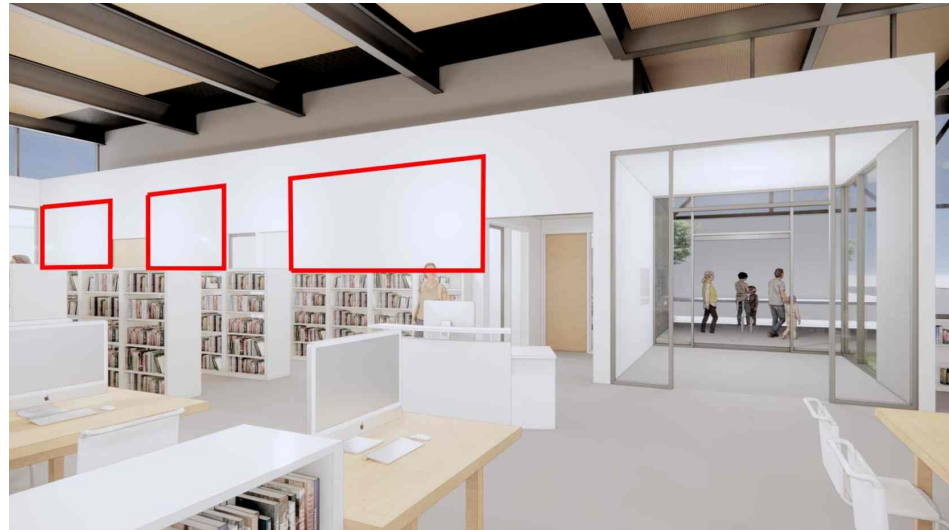
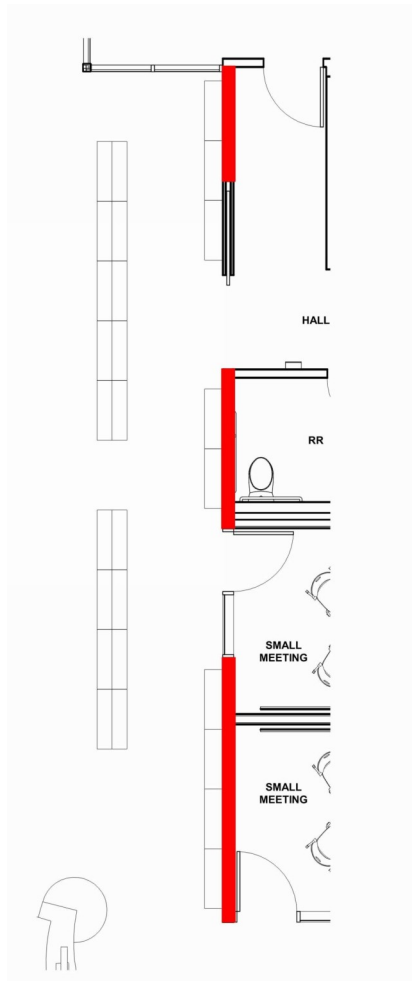

conc to pavers

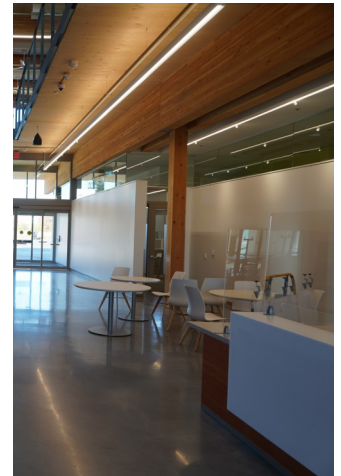
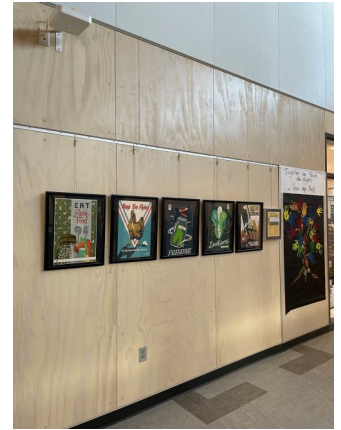

READING ROOM

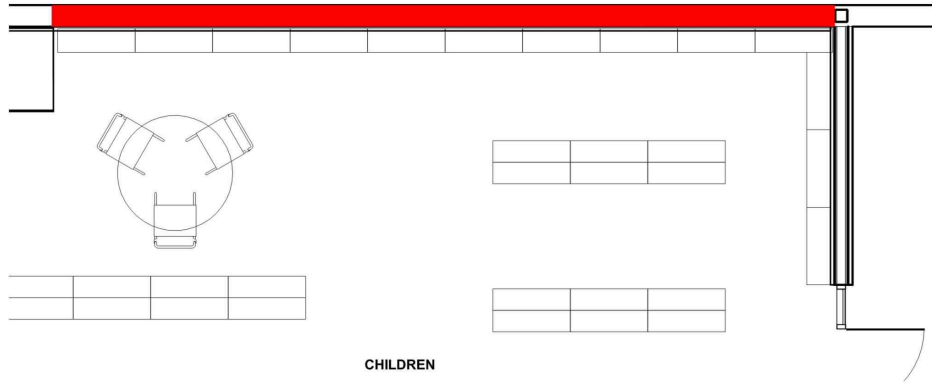


additional location - vestibule? People may move quickly thru vestibule

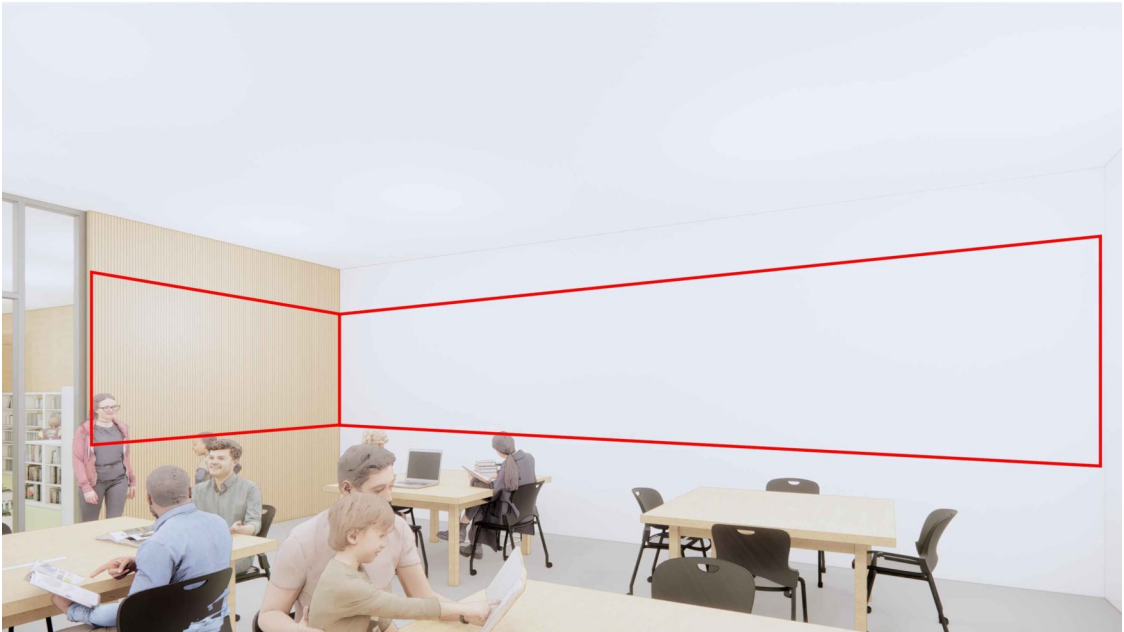
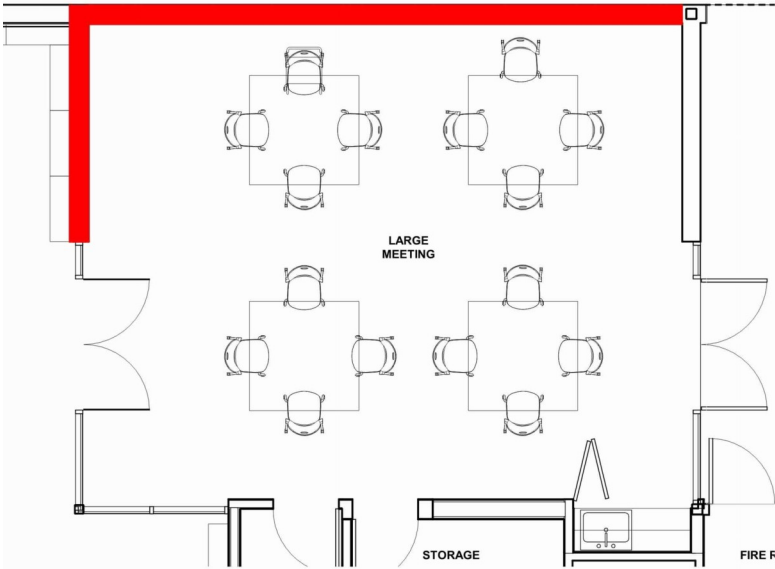
CHILDREN'S AREA

GRAPHIC WALL TEENS AREA

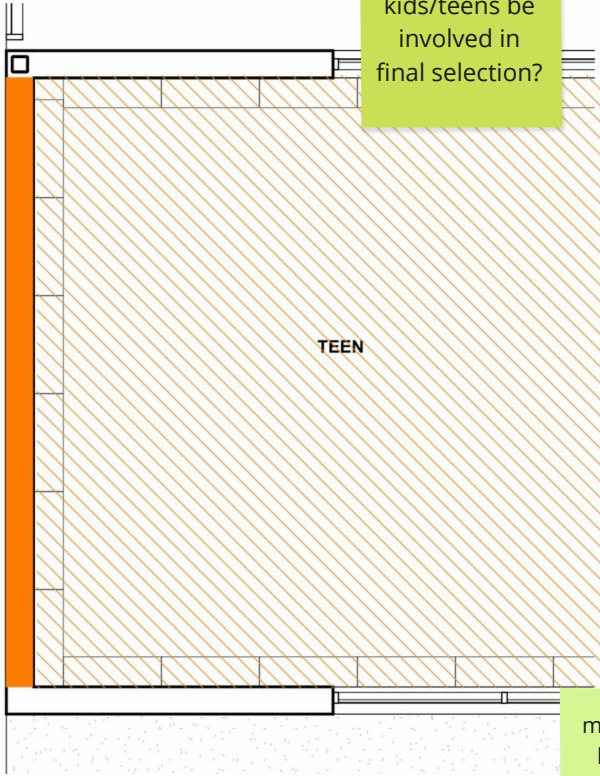
how could kids/teens be involved in final selection?

could this site be tied thematically to the exterior art sites

don't need to decommission a graphic wall - easier to replace over time

preference towards a calmer graphic

good to reference teens/ provide placemaking for the teen area.

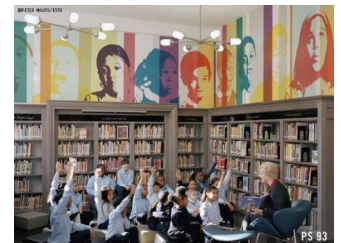


make sure that kids/shorter people can see a graphic wall above the stacks

consider furniture color

need to show some additional examples at next meeting - renderings?

these precedents are punchier - opportunities for quieter/nature based imagery



CLACKAMAS COUNTY ARTS ALLIANCE FEEDBACK

sculpture

could change yearly - or be permanent

permanent - recommend a call for artists

muralists

mural exchange every few years possible

encourage to pick a theme for art - early rather than later to help drive art selection

would encourage artists to join committee - Dianne can help pair us with an artist

rotating art

whole building could be rotating art sites (even sculpture)

artists exhibit program - 17 different places in the county currently.

affordable, and librarians dont have to manage it

sales - difficult to manage, recommend talking directly with the artist

annual fee - approx \$2500-\$3000 per year to rotate 4 times.

can be themed installs (winter, children, BIPOC artists, etc)

Public Art Process

can help with call for artist/ outreach

2. art team could handle final selection

art committee determine description for public art (ie exterior, wall mounted sculpture with nature theme, and artist's stipend)

1. artists submit proposals to CCAA

process length - approx 2months
