i. Approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Metropolitan Area Joint Computer Aided Dispatch System (MAJCS) for Regional Tech Support for 900 Computer Aided Dispatch Services. Total value is \$75,000 funded through 911 agencies in Clackamas, Washington and Columbia Counties with the Clackamas portion of \$22,342 annually, being paid through a combination of 911 tax and public safety user agency funds.
