2018-2019 YTD fatal crash summary:

In the month of December the County had 1 fatality which was due to intoxication. In the month of January the County had 3 Fatal- 2 crashes and 3 fatalities. Both crashes were submerged in water.

The committee requested information on long-term trends for fatal crashes and pedestrian crashes. Christian will provide this data next month.

Update: Filling the vacancies- No updates, re-advertise and ask PGA to do Next Door press release.
