 - c. Z0581-18, Larue Larry Franklin, 18024 S Steiner Road, Beavercreek, zoned RRFF5, 1.19 acres, requesting renewal of a level 3 home occupation to use a



- 12'x35' (420 sq. ft.) area of an existing pole barn to operate a fishing lure business. Approved subject to conditions.
- d. Z0602-18-C, Brian Gornick (applicant Brian Lee, PACE Engineers), 16017 S Henrici Rd, Oregon City, zoned RRFF5, 15.7 acres, public hearing 1/13/19 9:30 a.m., requesting an event venue hosting events to include weddings, etc. and proposed development includes use of a barn structure, parking lot & other outside use areas. Max. 200 guests with addl. limits per ZDO Section 806.
- e. Z0596-18, OC School District 362, Wes Rogers, 21944 S Yeoman Rd, Beavercreek, zoned EFU, 9.37 acres, requesting an alteration of a non-conforming use to authorize proposed modifications to existing school parking lots, and to provide additional school parking area, at the south of the subject property along S Steiner Road & north of the existing school. Approved subject to conditions.

Z0511-18, Z0512-18, Z0513-18, Metro Service Dist., Parks & Green Spaces, Water Quality Boundary Verification & Development Construction Mapping Plan, zoned timber, 91.23 acres, requesting construction of a pedestrian bridge stream crossing within the Water Quality Resource Area of a tributary to Tumble Creek, in conjunction with the construction of pedestrian trails for Metro's 318 acre Newell Creek Canyon Natural Area. Approved subject to Habitat Conservation & Water Quality Resource Area District conditions.
