The measure, if approved, would authorize the City of Sandy to impose an additional motor vehicle fuel tax at the rate of 3-cents per gallon for motor vehicle fuel sold, used, or distributed in Sandy.

In 2002, Sandy voters approved the creation of a local motor vehicle fuel tax, at a tax rate of 1-cent per gallon. In 2009, City Council approved the fuel tax increase to 2-cents per gallon. ORS 319.950 now requires voter approval to amend any provision in the local tax program and an additional 3-cents per gallon would bring the total local motor vehicle fuel tax to 5-cents per gallon.

The Sandy City Council has determined that an increase of 3-cents per gallon will be used for new construction of key roads in the Transportation System Plan. Certain high priority road projects have been identified including, but not limited to, an extension of 362^{nd} Drive north from the Highway 26 intersection to Bell Street, an extension of Bell Street west from the Sandy High School property to 362^{nd} Drive, an extension of Kate Schmidt Avenue north from Highway 26 to Bell Street, and an extension of Dubarko Road eastward to connect to U.S. Highway 26. The goal behind these street connections is to alleviate congestion at other intersections and provide additional connectivity to city residents.

While the program will focus on capital street projects, proceeds from the net tax could be spent on maintenance, pedestrian connections, and other transportation-related expenses.
