OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Selection of TSC representative for Community Road Fund Advisory Committee:

Discussion around the Community Road Fund Advisory Committee and the commitment of the committee member. This member would be on an advisory board that will help in deciding proposed projects. The meetings would be held in the evening and one member from the TSC would be representing. Members (Bob, Nathan, Jim and Robert) have expressed interest but more information is needed to commit to the advisory committee.

May & YTD fatal crash summary:

There was one fatality in the month of May on HWY 35- roll over crash. This fatal brings the total to 12 this year. The county is now below where we were at this time last year (15 through May 2018).

County Fair planning:

A sign-in sheet for the TSC booth was passed around for committee members to volunteer. The county fair is a great time to engage with citizens and promote traffic safety and safe driving. We will have the safety wheel, prizes and safety questions. Our booth will be in a new location this year next to the Drive to Zero booth. This one of a few events that the TSC will be involved in throughout the year. Christian will take an inventory of current giveaway items to see what needs to be ordered for the fair. Look at getting a wheel to help demonstrate the reflectors along with getting the inventory of displaying the ODOT informational pamphlets.

Radar speed feedback sign:

Discussion on moving the radar speed sign to a new location. As of right now, the radar speed sign will not be moved at the Redland location. Christian is looking into getting a new sign to be allocated for the TSC.

Intersection of Aldercrest and Oatfield- Switch back area where alder crest meets

Oatfield: Trucks getting stuck in the switchback area and semi-trucks are being towed. Jessie is wondering if we can get a sign posted warning on speed and corner. There has been a lot of a guardrail hits over the past year. There is a radar solar power sign that is posted to notify the driver. Christian to look into and ask the motor carrier safety division to see if there is any length road restrictions for this particular part of the road. This particular road might be in the City limits of Milwaukie. Christian will follow up on jurisdiction and possible resolution.

Recruitment: Interview candidates
