#### **BACKGROUND:**

Each fiscal year it is necessary to reduce or allocate additional sources of revenue and appropriate additional expenditures to more accurately meet the changing requirements of the operating departments. The attached resolution reflects such changes requested by departments in keeping with a legally accurate budget. These changes are in compliance with Oregon Local Budget Law ORS 294.433 - ORS 294.481, which allows for governing body approval of budget changes under qualified circumstances. The required notice has been published.

Clackamas County completed a county-wide Equal Pay Analysis (EPA) in December 2021, to comply with the Oregon Equal Pay Law. This analysis included a review of all county jobs in order to group jobs with work of comparable character to identify and correct any wage disparities among employees performing work of comparable character (peers). On March 8, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners approved moving forward with salary adjustments for some individual employees to align with the County's compensation philosophy with an effective date of January 1, 2022.

The effect of this resolution is a change in budget appropriation categories of \$4,700,000; from General Fund-Contingency to General Fund-Operating Expenses for the processing of EPA payments to impacted employees.
