Outreach Overview

- Clackamas County is moving forward with planning for two new libraries: one in Oak Lodge and one within the City of Gladstone.
- PGA staff, City of Gladstone staff, and a public involvement consultant are managing the public outreach process.
- The **public has been**—and continues to be—engaged in providing input on library location, design, and services.

Oak Lodge Library: Outreach so Far

- Ongoing communications: website updates, emails, and social media outreach
- Meeting with leaders of local community groups to shape the public outreach process (Dec 2017)
- Meetings with local CPOs
- Public meeting: Jan 29, 2018
- Online open house: Jan-Feb 2018

Public outreach reached 800 residents:

- ~ 150 public meeting attendees
- ~ 700 online open house visitors

- Access is critical. (Parking + walking, biking, bus access)
- Focus on programs for young people. (Spaces for teens and children, and educating young people)

- Partnership with local public school libraries: to engage students in visioning

Gladstone Library: Ballot Measure

The next step in constructing the envisioned Gladstone Library is...

- Gladstone residents must vote "yes" on a ballot measure to authorize construction of a new library.
- Measure will be part of May 2018 ballot.
