Oregon White Oak—single tree

This tree is located in an Oregon White Oak grove located off of Maple Lane in the Milwaukie area of unincorporated Clackamas County. This single Oregon White Oak tree has the typical savannah formation and is the most significant specimen on the property.

Oregon White Oak is a slow-growing species and can reach up to 90 feet at maturity. The species has an average life-span of 95 to 135 years.

The exact age of this tree is unknown, but it is believed to be approximately 175 years, the same as the surrounding grove of white oak trees in the area. The tree's age exceeds the species' average lifespan.

This tree is nominated and approved under the Heritage Tree category of specimen.
