EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Heightened emphasis placed on immigration and customs enforcement by the federal government has created confusion and consternation about the role of public sector jurisdictions like Clackamas County with respect to immigration and customs enforcement. Many undocumented people are living in fear of deportation.

The BCC continues to receive requests to partner with other government officials, civil rights and social justice advocacy groups, and concerned people in formal declarations of non-support for immigration and customs enforcement.

This policy session is designed to give BCC members the opportunity to learn what is happening with regard to immigration and customs enforcement in Clackamas County as well as the impact it is having relative to the County's commitment and ability to provide law enforcement and County services to undocumented immigrants.
