STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

1. <u>Prior to the Hearing</u>. You have the right to make the following requests:

- (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
- (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
- (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. <u>Procedure</u>. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to
- represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence.
- The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. <u>Record of Proceedings</u>. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. <u>Hearings Officer</u>. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. - 5. <u>Right to Recess</u>. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Diane Bautista, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is:

30810 SE Heiple Rd., Estacada, OR 97023, also known as T3S, R4E, Section 08, Tax Lot 02900,

and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

On or about the 1st day of February, 2022 Respondent violated the following laws,

in the following ways:

a. Respondent violated the Clackamas County Building Code, Title 9.02 by failing to obtain required permits and final approved inspections. This violation is a Priority 1 violation

pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

On or about the 12th day of May, 2022 Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Respondent violated the Clackamas County Building Code, Title 9.02 by failing to obtain required permits and final approved inspections. This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

Notice of the violations was given to Respondent in the following manner: Citation and Complaint #2100063-1 in the amount of \$100.00 was mailed via first class mail on February 1, 2022. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit D, and incorporated by this reference.

Notice of the violations was given to Respondent in the following manner: Citation and Complaint #2100063-2 in the amount of \$500.00 was mailed via first class mail on May 12, 2022. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit E, and incorporated by this reference.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief: 1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;

Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for a Building Code Title 9.02 Priority 1 violation being \$750.00 to \$1,000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code.

 Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code;

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

February 24, 2021	Clackamas County received a complaint regarding marijuana processing without required permits.	
March 3, 2021 Exhibit A	Correspondence was sent to the Respondent with a deadline of April 3, 2021 to obtain required permits and approved final inspections.	
June 9, 2021 Exhibit B	County received an email with an attachment that the Respondent sent to their tenant regarding their lease agreement.

February 1, 2022	I reviewed the permit system and found that no permits had been obtained.	
February 1, 2022 Exhibit D	Citation 2100063-1 was issued for failure to obtain required permits and was sent via first class mail. Citation mailed first class mail was not returned. This citation has not been paid.	
May 12, 2022	I reviewed the permit system and found that no permits had been obtained.	
May 12, 2022 Exhibit E	Citation 2100063-2 was issued for failure to obtain required permits and was sent via first class mail. Citation mailed first class mail was not returned. Citation has not been paid.	
June 16, 2022	The County referred this matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.	

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position by a preponderance of the evidence, the County may request a Continuing Order in this matter recommending the following:

• The Respondent be ordered to bring the property into compliance with the Building Code within 30 days of the date of the Continuing order by obtaining required permits and receive final approved inspections within 30 days of the permits being issued.

- Code Enforcement to confirm compliance of the above items and the County will submit a post hearing status report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent.
- The report may include the following recommendations:
- The imposition of civil penalties for the building code violations of up to \$1,000.00 for each date cited February 1, 2022 and May 12, 2022. For a total amount due of \$2,000.00
- Payment for Citation No. 2100063-1 issued on February 1, 2022 for \$100.00 and Citation No. 2100063-2 issued on May 12, 2022 for \$500.00. For a total amount due of \$600.00.
- The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from April 2021 until the violation is abated. As of this report the total is \$1,125.00.
- The County requests the Hearings Officer to permanently prohibit the Respondent from violating this law in the future.
- If the Respondent fails to comply with the Hearings Officer's Continuing Order the County will request the Hearings Officer to issue a Final Order and will also request the Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.

Marijuana Processing without required permits

Operating a commercial marijuana processing business without required permits constitutes a violation of Clackamas County Code Title 9.02.040 (A), (B), (C), and (D). To abate these violations you must complete the following **no later than April 3, 2021:**

- Obtain required permits:
 - Submit the building, plumbing, mechanical and electrical permit applications, and technically complete plans and pay the appropriate fee(s).
 - The permit must be picked up within ten (10) days of being notified that the permit is ready.
 - Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained no later than 45 days from the date of the permit being issued, or;
- Cease the commercial activity and schedule a site inspection to confirm.

REQUIRED NOTICE OF FINES AND PENALTIES

It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, (2) assessment of a \$75 per month administrative compliance fee, and (3) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

Clackamas County Code provides for fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.

Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.

Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Road.

Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearing Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel; for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.

Finally, recurrence of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.

Good Afternoon,

Permit B0302218 for Change of Use and construction of improvements for this Extraction Lab has expired. I sent a plan review letter on July 30 2018 needing more information to continue the review which was not responded to. Mechanical Permit B0646618 has also expired, my last contact on January 31 2019 was with Jack of Bull Mountain Heating also needing more information. Electrical Permit E565318 has also expired. Only Plumbing Permit P0148518 for a utility sink has been completed. We no longer have the files for the expired permits, I imagined they have been purged or for some other reason cannot be located. It is also possible the original land use approval may have been affected.

The codes have also changed since the permits were originally applied for. Therefore resubmittal for these permits will be required. At this time we only accept electronic submittals for electronic plan review. We no longer accept paper files. Please resubmit and be advised an Engineering Peer Review is now required by both the building department and fire department for review and approval of Extraction Labs.
