English Walnut Tree

The Westerngreen English Walnut tree is located on land in the agriculture district of unincorporated Clackamas County. The property includes a farm house built in 1900.

The tree is well-aged with a height of approximately 45 feet and a canopy spread of 50 to 60 feet. The tree provides abundant shade in summer.

The English Walnut tree qualifies under the heritage tree specimen and historic criteria.
