- SECTION 2. SELECTION OF OFFICERS. The first election shall be held at the
 first meeting of the Hoodland CPO. After the first election, the election of
 officers of the Hoodland CPO shall be held at the annual meeting. Officers shall
 assume their duties immediately upon election to office. All members are
 eligible for election to officer positions. Proxy votes shall not be allowed.
- SECTION 3. TERM OF SERVICE. The term of office for all officers shall be one year, however, the officers shall continue to serve until a successor is elected or appointed to that office. Officers may serve multiple years.
- SECTION 4. VACANCIES. A vacancy occurs when an officer, dies, resigns, is removed, is no longer eligible to serve, or has more than two unexcused absences from meetings. A vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the chairperson. The person appointed to fill the vacancy shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term and until a successor is elected or appointed to that office.
- SECTION 5. NOMINATING COMMITTEE. A nominating committee shall be appointed by the chairperson at least 30 days prior to the annual meeting. This committee shall present its recommended list of candidates at the annual meeting. No person may be confirmed as a nominee without the permission of the nominated person.
