- Pawn shops will hold firearms and will charge a fee to hold them and upon return will do so with a background check.
- The Oregon Firearm safety coalition meets and everyone is welcome to join. Notify Donna-Marie if interested.
- In the past, we have held listening sessions within the Latinx Community, working to develop culturally appropriate training.
- Received \$20k grant to create welcome packages, which will contain security storage boxes, info, resources, etc. Hoping to hand out 150-200 by May 2024. The goal is for every new gun owner to receive a box.
- Held a free firearm culture training over the summer and received great feedback. Also had a firearm panel to help understand why someone carries a firearm.
