EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Clackamas Health Centers (CHC) is partnered with Oregon Health & Science University (OSHU) to participate in an IRB study focused on opioid addictions. The National Institutes of Health awarded grants from the Justice Community Opioid Innovation Network (JCOIN) to support research on quality addiction treatment for opioid use disorder in criminal justice settings nationwide. OHSU is a part of the JCOIN network and has been sponsoring CHC as a participant in this study. OHSU will be accessing CHC patients currently incarcerated with the Corrections Department.

This amendment extends the period of performance through July 31, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of this amendment.
