AMEND: Article I.3

3. Consideration. The County agrees to pay Contractor, from available and authorized funds, a sum not to exceed ***Fifty thousand dollars \$50,000***, for accomplishing the Work required by this Contract. Consideration rates are on fixed fee basis in accordance with the rates and costs specified in Exhibit B. If any interim payments to Contractor are made, such payments shall be made only in accordance with the schedule and requirements in Exhibit B.

TO READ:

3. Consideration. The County agrees to pay Contractor, from available and authorized funds, a sum not to exceed ***seventy-seven thousand, six hundred fifty two dollars and eight cents \$77,562.08***, for accomplishing the Work required by this Contract. Consideration rates are on fixed fee basis in accordance with the rates and costs specified in Exhibit B. If any interim payments to Contractor are made, such payments shall be made only in accordance with the schedule and requirements in Exhibit B.
