EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: On Monday, August 21, 2017, all of North America will be treated to an eclipse of the sun. Anyone within the path of totality can see this awe-inspiring sight. The path of totality, where the moon completely covers the sun, will stretch from Lincoln Beach, Oregon to Charleston, South Carolina.

Clackamas County will be in the path of totality along the southern border to around 98% of totality in the remainder of the County. This rare event is attracting visitors to Oregon in what is expected to be record numbers and represents both opportunities and challenges, including an increase in tourism, to our beautiful county, along with the possibility of very heavy traffic. In this Study Session presenters will provide information on planning efforts throughout Clackamas County. The County has worked with our local cities, public safety, tourism, and state and federal partners to consider our community needs during the impact days and has developed contingency plans for resources and staffing.
