Timeline



- Design: Nov. 2019 May 2022
 - 95% and Final Plans and Specifications
 - Completed work to minimize impacts to adjacent properties
- Right of way (ROW): Jan. 2021 May 2022
 - Process
 - On-going negotiations with property owners
 - Staff will follow the federal ROW Uniform Act process
- Construction: Fall 2022 Summer 2023


Improving safety and connectivity

- Constructing a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side
- Adding marked crosswalks, flashing beacons and radar speed feedback
- Constructing 7-foot bicycle lanes on both sides
- Establishing 11-foot travel lanes
- Moving the marked pedestrian crossing at Rose Lane to Portland Ave., and adding a Rapid Rectangular Beacon and radar speed feedback response
- Improving stormwater facilities, including constructing a bioswale and detention area upstream of the Boardman Creek crossing
