Board of County Commissioners Acting as the Governing Body of Water Environment Services Clackamas County

Approval of a Supplemental Budget Resolution for Water Environment Services for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. Fiscal impact is a transfer of appropriations of \$380,000. Funding through Water Environment Services' Surface Water Operating Fund and Surface Water Construction Fund. No County General Funds are involved.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Each fiscal year it is necessary to reduce or allocate additional sources of revenue and appropriate additional expenditures to more accurately meet the changing requirements of Water Environment Services ("WES").

The attached resolution reflects such changes requested by WES in keeping with a legally accurate budget.

An increase in FY 2022-23 appropriations for capital outlay in WES' Surface Water Construction Fund is needed to accommodate 1) increased spending on small drainage projects to address flooding of roadways and properties; 2) the addition of the Aldercrest Culvert and Kellogg Creek Restoration and SE Clackamas Road Drainage Infrastructure projects as approved for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding by the Board of County Commissioners in October 2022; and 3) increased FY 2022-23 spending for the 3-Creeks Water Quality Project due to progress on the project occurring ahead of schedule.

The attached resolution increases Capital Outlay for Surface Water projects by \$380,000 via a reduction in the Surface Water Construction Fund Contingency of \$247,500 and an increase in the transfer from the Surface

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Page 2 of 2 Water Operating Fund to the Surface Water Construction Fund of \$132,500 via a reduction in the Surface Water Operating Fund Contingency of \$132,500.

These changes are in compliance with Oregon Local Budget Law ORS 294.433 through ORS 294.481 and ORS 294.900 through ORS 294.930, which allows for governing body approval of budget changes under qualified circumstances. Notice of this public hearing and a financial summary were published in The Oregonian on March 17, 2023.

The effect of this resolution is an increase in appropriations of \$132,500.

The attached resolution has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.

RECOMMENDATION: WES staff recommends the Board, acting as the governing body of Water Environment Services, adopt the attached Resolution Providing Authorization Regarding Adoption of a Supplemental Budget and Making Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2022-23.

WHEREAS, this matter comes before the Board of County Commissioners of Clackamas County, Oregon, as the governing body of Water Environment Services (the "Board").

WHEREAS, changing requirements throughout Fiscal Year 2022-23 resulted in additional expenditures from Water Environment Services' Surface Water Construction Fund, which necessitates the adoption of a supplemental budget;

WHEREAS, a supplemental budget for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, inclusive, has been prepared and published in accordance with ORS 294.925 and ORS 294.473, and the notice of this public hearing and a financial summary were published in The Oregonian on March 17, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing to discuss the supplemental budget was held before the Board on March 30, 2023.

WHEREAS, the funds being adjusted are the Surface Water Operating Fund and the Surface Water Construction Fund;

It further appearing that it is in the best interest of Water Environment Services to approve this change in appropriations for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Clackamas County, acting as the governing body of Water Environment Services, resolves as follows:

1. Pursuant to the authority provided in ORS 294.433 through ORS 294.481, and ORS 294.900 through ORS 294.930, the supplemental budget for Fiscal Year 2022-23 is hereby adopted and appropriations are established as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference herein; and
