ISSUE & BACKGROUND

A Citizen Participation Policy was adopted in 1973 as Board Order No. 73-1659. This Policy established the Community Planning Organizations (CPOs) and created specific recognition requirements for CPOs. The CPO program is one method that accomplishes Citizen Involvement, Goal 1 of the Statewide Planning Goals, for Clackamas County.

The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) reviews the activity status of CPOs annually and officially recognizes the CPOs that have taken the time and effort to meet the requirements by submitting the following information to the County:

- A list of current CPO officers including addresses, phone numbers and email addresses
- A copy of current CPO bylaws
- A copy of meeting minutes from at least two publicly-noticed meetings during the calendar year

Of the 43 original geographic areas for which a CPO may be formed, three are now Hamlets (Beavercreek, Stafford, Mulino) and one Village (Villages at Mt. Hood). In addition, a new Hamlet is forming, Molalla Prairie. The Board of County Commissioners last approved annual recognition for 29 CPOs at the February 10, 2009 Study Session.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends the official recognition of the 31 CPOs listed below that have submitted the required information to the Office of Citizen Involvement for calendar year 2009:
