Over all this transition of about 100,000 came to Health Share. The county is continuing to look at how to expand our network. There are about 256 providers that were not part of Health Share and are vetting those who would like to join. They looked at those who had specialty as well as some medication management.</li> <li>➤ Mary advised that apparenently there is a clinic in another state with the name Riverstone that has been trademarked for years and the county received a Cease and Desist letter. Mary is working with county council regarding next steps. She expressed that she plans to</li> </ul>	

	have Riverstone have a more generic name so it is clear that this is a county clinic and there is no confusion by the public and no trademark issues in the future.
