Hi Jennifer,

Here is Public Health's comments regarding the proposed drive-thru flu shot clinic:

- Regarding COVID-19 precautions: People should stay in their cars (instruction signs perhaps?). There should be no more than 25 milling around outside in the tent, wearing masks and maintaining 6-foot distancing. In the interest of that being a public transit center and some people may arrive not in a car, develop a walk-up plan which includes a crowd control person, and include those people in the total maximum occupancy count. They should have a plan for cleaning the porta potty (touch surfaces) after each use and a hand sanitizer station outside the porta potty (and if possible a handwashing station too).
- We recommend that the site is smoke free (both cigarettes and vaping), especially in areas where people may be congregating outside of cars or getting walk up shots.
- We would like to note that Public Health is planning to partner with Kaiser to dispense flu shots in one lane for non-Kaiser patients. (Likely Wednesdays in October).
