Timeline

The Master Planning process will kick off in Spring 2019 with a completion date of Spring 2020.

Project history and goals

The Clackamas Heights Master Plan will provide a comprehensive redevelopment strategy for an aging Public Housing community. The site is 16.5 acres and presents incredible opportunity for increased housing density on an underutilized parcel in Oregon City.

The Master Plan is funded through a Metro 2040 Planning and Development grant. The expected development outcomes from the Master Plan are the construction of a mixed use, mixed income community that rebuilds existing affordable housing at the site, while creating opportunities for expanded housing choice, and the potential for commercial uses such as a new neighborhood grocery store and other economic development activities.

HACC will use the Master Plan to leverage federal, state and local funding opportunities including the RAD program, LIHTC, and New Markets Tax Credits. Each of these funding programs require significant site planning, community engagement and financial feasibility in order to be competitive.
