Agreement value increased to \$371,262.09 for 4 years and 3 months. Funding is through the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. No County General Funds are involved.

BACKGROUND: The Social Services Division of the Health, Housing, and Human Services Department requests approval of an Amendment to an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County by and through its Aging, Disability, and Veterans Services Division for the delivery of Veterans Directed Care (VDC) services to eligible Veterans who reside in Clackamas County. Clackamas County Social Services, as part of the State's Aging & Disability Resource Connection (ADRC) network, participates with Multnomah County to coordinate program delivery for VDC services.

The goal of the VDC program is to provide case management support to veterans who are in need of nursing care at home, have needs that exceed the hours available through the VA's Homemaker/ Home Health Aid Program, and are interested in self-directed care. These services and supports allow them to remain independent and engaged in their community as long as possible.

In the last two years, the Veterans Directed Care program has served 44 Clackamas County veterans, and eight additional veterans remain on a waitlist seeking services. A spouse of a Vet expressed gratitude for this program as she is not able to provide the care that her husband required, but because of this program, he was able to be released from the hospital, still have his care needs met, and pass in his home - which is what he wanted.

RECOMMENDATION: The staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve this amendment and authorize Chair Smith to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AMENDMENT Contract Number: DCHS-IGA-E-13872-2022 Amendment Number: 1

This Amendment No. 1 ("<u>Amendment</u>") to DCHS-IGA-E-13872-2022 ("<u>Contract</u>") is between Multnomah County ("<u>County</u>") and CLACKAMAS COUNTY OF (formerly CLACKAMAS COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION) ("<u>Agency</u>"), each of whom is a "<u>Party</u>" and collectively they are the "<u>Parties</u>". Except as otherwise noted, the meanings of defined terms in the Amendment are the same as those used in the Contract. The effective date of this Amendment is Monday, April 1, 2024.

The Parties agree as follows:

- The termination date of this Contract is extended from 3/31/2024 11:59 PM to 6/30/2026 11:59 PM.
- 2. The following changes are made, effective April 1, 2024:

Paragraphs 12.A. and 12.B. in Intergovernmental Agreement are replaced in their entirety, as follows:

- A. Full or Partial Assessment (one-time assessment fee) of \$1,017.94 for each full assessment (new Veteran referred and accepted into the program) for an estimated maximum of 8 full assessments per County fiscal year or \$508.97 for each partial assessment (Veteran assessed as a poor candidate for the program) for an estimated maximum of 4 partial assessments per County fiscal year.
- B. Professional Fees Consultation (case management fee) of \$569.10 per Veteran per month for an estimated maximum of 360 consultations per County fiscal year.
- 3. The estimated target value of this requirements Contract is \$371,262.09, which includes \$53,763.85 in additional funding for the three-month period 4/1/2024 through 6/30/2024.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain the same.
