Schedule Update



- August-September 2021: Public feedback on intersection improvement options at virtual open house
- January 2022: 60% design documents completed, reflect public input
- Summer 2022-23: Contact property owners with right of way construction easement impacts; working to minimize
- Now-2023: Continue refining design
- 2024-25: Construction; begins in 2024 because of increased costs for roundabout, takes two years for utility relocation and road work

Funding: \$12.6 million



• Community Road Fund*: \$8.2 million



 Transportation System Development Charges (TSDCs) -- \$4.4 million

What we'll be doing: Stafford-Childs



Improve safety and capacity

- Add a roundabout
- Replace the culvert
- Build a retaining wall




What we'll be doing: Stafford-Johnson



Improve safety and capacity

Eliminate road skew

- Reduce steep grades on Johnson
- Increase sight distance
- Eliminate left turn onto Stafford
 - Reduce 'shooting the gap'
 - Reduce congestion on Johnson
- Dedicated southbound left-turn lane
 - Reduce congestion on Stafford
 - Reduce rear-end crashes



What we'll be doing: Stafford bike lanes



Add paved bike lanes, Pattulo to Rosemont

- Widening primarily east side of road because of proximity to Pecan Creek
- Symmetrical widening north of Childs Rd
- Steep cut slopes on east side; guardrail on west side
- Improved cross slope (super elevation) of roadway for a smoother ride
