STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

1. <u>Prior to the Hearing</u>. You have the right to make the following requests:

- (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
- (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
- (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. <u>Procedure</u>. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to
- represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence.
- The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. <u>Record of Proceedings</u>. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. <u>Hearings Officer</u>. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. - 5. <u>Right to Recess</u>. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

		COMPLAINT AN	ND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Shane Potter, Code Compliance Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondents' mailing address is: 3203 Brighton St., Philadelphia, PA 19149

The address or location of the violations of law alleged in this Complaint is:

17010 S McCubbin Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045 also known as T2S, R3E., Section 32,

Tax Lot 00300, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 9th day of March, 2022, Respondents violated the following laws, in the following ways:

Respondents violated Title 9.02.040 of the Clackamas County Building Code by installing electrical and mechanical devices without a permit and inspections, on the above referenced property.

This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities. The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Compliance Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violations was given to Respondents in the following manner: Administrative Citation No. 2100206 - 1 in the amount of \$500.00 was mailed on June 27, 2022. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit G, and incorporated by this reference.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to immediately abate the violation and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining respondents from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondents for each violation within the range established by Board of County Commissioners. Said range for a Priority 1 violation being \$750.00 to \$1,000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code; 3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code; and

4. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

History of Events and Exhibits:

May 24, 2021 Exhibit A	Clackamas County received a complaint regarding a marijuana grow in an agricultural building and garage converted into an indoor grow room without permits.
May 25, 2021 Exhibit B	Letter of correspondence mailed to the owners mailing address and to the physical site.
June 1, 2021 through June 28, 2021 Exhibit C	Email exchanges with the owner Xin Huang and Clackamas County Code Enforcement Specialist (CES) Shane Potter by email.
June 14, 2021 Exhibit D	Clackamas County Sheriff's Deputy Tony Mayer performed a site visit and visited the garage and large red barn. Deputy Mayer stated there was large quantities of equipment for a hydro grow of marijuana with a few marijuana leaves on the ground. Smelled like a recent harvest. Deputy Mayer also provided photos he took during the site visit.
July 20, 2021	Owner Xin Huang came into the County offices to turn in land use applications for a marijuana grow.
February 10, 2022 Exhibit E	CES Potter performed a site visit from the right of way. The day was cool and foggy. There was no smell of marijuana at the time of the site visit.
March 9, 2022 Exhibit F	Facts of the alleged violation were reviewed, the violation for unpermitted work was verified, and notice of the violation was mailed containing a statement of the facts that support the finding a violation exists on the property. The Notice of Violation was mailed first class mail on this date.

June 23, 2022	I researched the permit history to see if any permits have been obtained for the work in the garage and none were shown.
June 27, 2022 Exhibit G	Citation #2100206 – 1 issued for a building code violation sent first class mail. The first class mail was not returned. This citation has not been paid.
January 5, 2023	Research of permits in the County do not show any electrical and/or mechanical permits for this site being issued to address the violations in the garage and agricultural building.
January 18, 2023	The County referred this matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

- 1. If the Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the building code for unpermitted electrical and HVAC installations in the garage and the agricultural building on site then the County would request a Continuing Order be issued to the Respondent to:
 - Submit technically complete plans, if required, and obtain permits for electrical and mechanical work done in the garage and agricultural building or by properly removing the mechanical and obtaining an electrical permit for removing the electrical, along with paying all fees, within 15 days of the date of the continuing order;
 - Schedule all inspections so that final approved inspections may be obtained within 45 days of the date of the Continuing Order
- 2. The County will submit a Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:
 - Payment of Citation #2100206 1 in the amount of \$500.00
 - The imposition of civil penalties up to \$1,000.00
 - The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from March 2022. As of the date of this report this total would be \$750.00.
- 3. If the violations are not abated the County may request authorization for further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.
- 4. The County requests the Hearing's Officer to permanently enjoin the Respondent from violating these laws in the future.
- 5. If penalties, fines, and fees are imposed in the final order in this matter, the County requests the Hearing's Officer order the Respondent to reimburse the County for any expenses the County may incur collecting these monies.



I did talk with your friend on the phone. We agreed that during the site visit the Deputy confirmed the marijuana had been removed, but there was a recent grow in there and you will need to obtain Clackamas County Land Use Approval for a grow in the future if you choose to grow beyond the personal use allowance.

As for the electrical you will have to do one of two things: First you can remove all the electrical in there and obtain an electrical permit for capping the electrical and get an inspection to confirm it was removed by code. Or the other option is to obtain an electrical permit. We are unable to provide any other options as electrical requires a permit regardless of the use. Please let me know which option you and choose and when you expect to have the work done.


