District Advisory Committee (DAC)

Evaluates & makes recommendations to NCPRD Governing Board

regarding:

- Programs, facilities, parks, sports fields, buildings, property acquisition, budget, and annual work plan
- Addresses challenges, desires, and needs of all district residents

District Advisory Committee (DAC)

The NCPRD Governing-Board “BCC” is expanding community input in the unincorporated areas of North Clackamas County

- Historical under-representation of unincorporated areas
- Led to uneven District wide resource distribution, lost park and open-space opportunities, and District expansion opportunities
- This is a great opportunity for more residents to participate

History of NCPRD

1990 - Ballot Measure established to **serve unincorporated areas** - includes City of Milwaukie

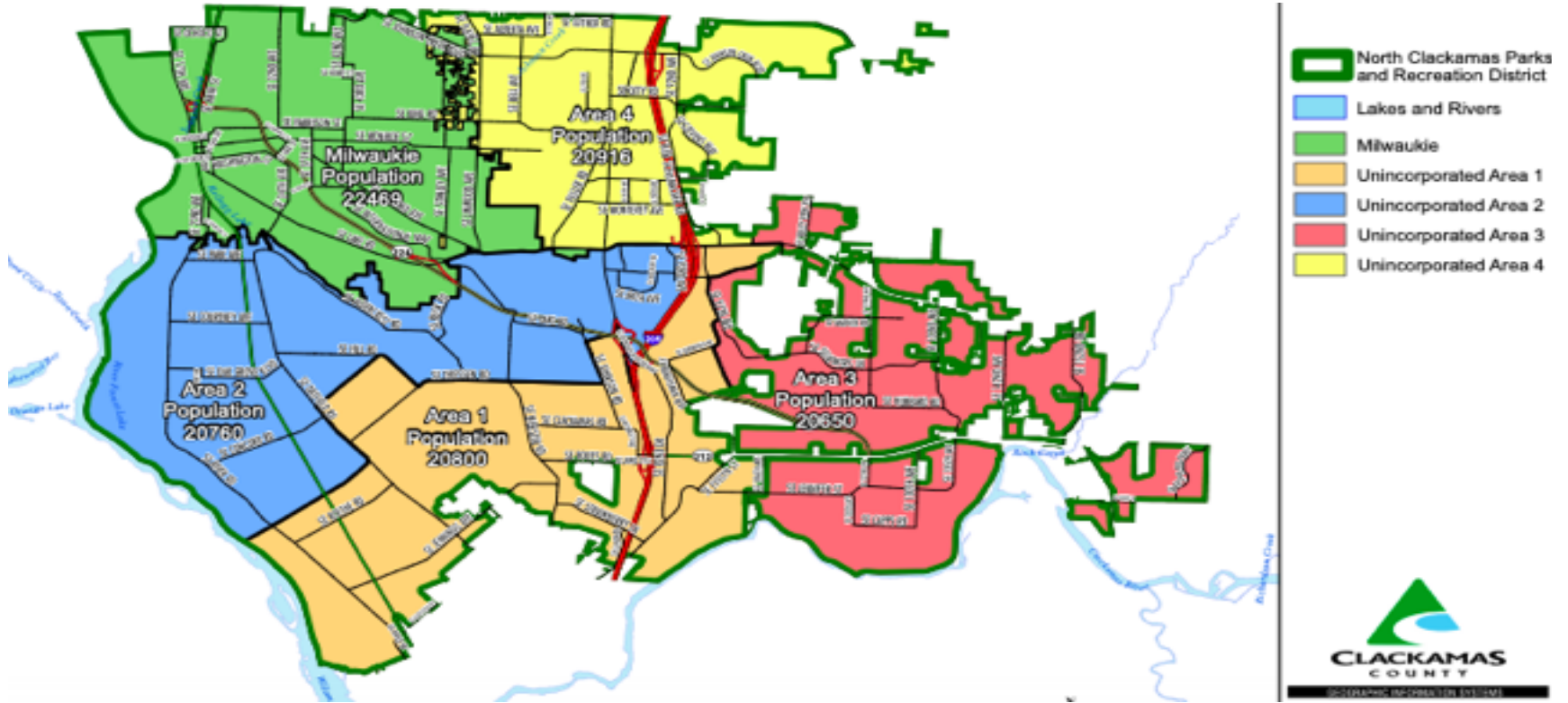
- District established 5-Neighborhood Parks sub-areas Advisory Committees with each selecting representatives to NCPRD-DAB (now DAC)

2004 - 2019

- Happy Valley joins District and NCPRD separated into 3-Zone with funding restrictions
- Happy Valley initiates departing NCPRD / DAB suspended
- **Many feel there has been a lack of even distribution of funding and resources**

2019 - BCC directs DAB to update bylaws to provide proportional representation Throughout NCPRD.

Unincorporated sub-areas input improved with proportional design



How can we choose who represents us for NCPRD DAC?

The Bylaws IV(e) provide for direct nomination by “nominating committees”

- **Applicants will be recruited and nominated by each sub-area’s nominating committee** (made up of residents living within each particular sub-area)
- Task Force - process for selecting sub-area representatives
