QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates must currently be or have been certified as a basic police officer within the last five (5) years and have completed at least eighteen (18) months of law enforcement experience as a uniformed civilian peace officer.

Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) maintains authority to determine acceptable lateral transfer of out of state certification to Oregon.

NOTE: Candidates must successfully pass Frontline exam (unless currently DPSST certified or possess a bachelor's degree or higher), a comprehensive background investigation, fingerprinting, post offer pre- employment drug test, physical and psychological exam.
