Crisis Quarterly Data Review - Mary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Mary presented data regarding the crisis clinic and crisis line as well as data on other Safety Net Services provided by Clackamas County Crisis Clinic. 	
Committee Reports - All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Advocacy/Legislative Committee - Bill passed for 988-crisis line. Problem is some states have crisis lines that are managed by the counties and others are regional. If this becomes a regional/statewide resource it will takes money away from the local MH Authority (Counties) and give it to the state for this service. There was concern about local destabilization since for Oregon Counties, they are familiar with the people, area and resources near them. A nuance that a state run call line would not have. ➤ Aid & Assist bill is getting traction. Currently there is nothing in writing that protects the counties from bad outcomes. ➤ Firm arm bill regarding safe storage and concealed weapons. Requiring safe storage of firearms while in the home. Certain places that can say you cannot conceal carry. ➤ Nominating Committee - Recruitment closes at the end of the month for everyone to get his or her applications in. ➤ Sub-Committee (Older Adult) - No updates, waiting to start up with the community center project. ➤ Suicide Prevention Coalition of Clackamas County Update - No Updates
