Entry Fees:

\$10.00 per Open Class Exhibitor or \$5.00 per 4-H/FFA Crossover Exhibitor \$10.00 per head Entry form and fees are due in the fair office by June 28, 2019.

Rotations:

- 1. 1st Rotation: Classes: 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, and 106. Cattle must be in the barn by 11 PM Monday August 12, 2019 and will be released Wednesday August 14, 2019 (per Overall Livestock Superintendent). Animals must be removed by 8:30 PM.
- 2. 2nd Rotation: Classes: 107,108, 109, 110, 111 and 112. Will be allowed in the barn August 14, 2019 ONLY after all equipment is removed and cleaning is complete from 1st rotation. No tack or setup is allowed before this time, (per Overall Livestock Superintendent). All entries must be in the barn by 9:45 AM Thursday August 16, 2019. Entries are released at 8:00 PM Sunday August 18, 2019.

Specific Rules:

- 1. Exhibitors should read General Rules and Regulations and Livestock Department Rules located on the Clackamas County Fair website under Exhibitor Handbook.
- 2. Bedding must be furnished by the exhibitor.
- 3. All blowers that were manufactured with a prong plug must have a 3 prong plug to be used on the fair grounds.
- 4. Tack pen space for all open livestock is limited. **Open Beef maximum space will be:** 5' X 10'.
- 5. All cattle stalls and adjacent space must be kept neat and clean at all times. Failing to do so may result in forfeit of premium money and loss of participating in future years.
- 6. All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor with the exception of animals in the calf classes which can be papers pending. Registration certificates must be presented to the Beef Superintendent and will be checked prior to show time.
- 7. To be eligible in a group class, an animal must also be shown as an individual.
- 8. Group classes may be composed of animals kept on the same farm yet owned by different members of the family unit. Groups must be listed on the entry form.
- 9. All Bulls eight months or older shall be shown with a nose lead or ring.
- 10. HALTER AND NECK ROPE (DOUBLE TIED) ARE REQUIRED ON BEEF CATTLE AT ALL TIMES WHILE BEING STALLED.
