EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Social Services Division of the Department of Health, Housing and Human Services requests approval to apply to Oregon Department of Transportation Rail and Public Transit Division to fund vehicles for the Mt Hood Express. The Mt Hood Express provides public transit bus service between the City of Sandy, Government Camp and Timberline, along with other locations in the Mt. Hood area, increasing access to employment, recreation, shopping and medical services for residents and visitors.

Several planning projects are ongoing or planned in the Government Camp area, including the Rest Stop Relocation, Park and Ride, and Transit Hub projects. As these planning projects in and around Government Camp continue to progress it is imperative that additional vehicles be purchased for the Mt Hood Express and Village Shuttle services. These vehicles will be used to expand service and explore other service models that better fit updated Regional needs.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval to apply for this grant and further recommend the acceptance of the award if funded, and that Tootie Smith, Chair, be authorized to sign all documents

necessary to accomplish this action on behalf of the Board of Commissioners.

These funds support transportation services in the form of capital equipment purchases for MHX. These transportation services help support seniors and people with disabilities, rural residents and others in Clackamas County, many of which have no other transportation options.
2. Who, if any, are the community partners who might be better suited to perform this work? None
3. What are the objectives of this funding opportunity? How will we meet these objectives? Projects eligible to receive grant funding under the STIF Discretionary and Intercommunity Discretionary Funds include, but are not limited to capital, operations, technology, planning and research activities, including bicycle and pedestrian projects that facilitate greater access to transit services. Our project will fall under "capital activities" and will provide new capital investments.

The Mt Hood Express provides affordable public transit services between Sandy along the Highway 26 corridor to Government Camp, and then up to Timberline Lodge. This is an essential service to provide rural residents with access to employment and other essential services, as well as providing visitors a safe and accessible option to enjoy Mt Hood
