In 2016, the City of Newberg signed a two-year contract with Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue District (TVF&R) to provide fire protection, advanced emergency medical, and ambulance services. During the contract, elected leaders of TVF&R and Newberg evaluated the feasibility and cost-benefit of annexation. In June 2017, the Newberg City Council approved annexation to TVF&R, subject to voter approval. Voters residing within the City of Newberg voted on the question of annexation to TVF&R in Yamhill County measure 36-190. The outcome of that November 8, 2017, election was 69.32% in favor of annexation.

This measure seeks approval of the annexation from voters residing in TVF&R's existing service area. Once annexed, the City of Newberg residents will pay the same tax rate as existing TVF&R patrons. They will also become eligible to vote for TVF&R directors and on any future TVF&R property tax proposals. This measure will not increase taxes paid by existing TVF&R patrons. (154 words)
