Coop In Time:

1. The Poultry Show is held throughout the fair. Birds will be accepted Monday, August 12, 2019 from Noon to 9:00 PM.
2. Entries will be released between 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM (Per Fair Management) Sunday August 18, 2019.

Specific Rules:

1. Exhibitors should read General Rules and Regulations and Livestock Department Rules found on Clackamas County Fair website under Exhibitor Handbook.
2. There will be no entries accepted the day of coop in.
3. **No birds allowed in the barn until passing health check overseen by the Superintendent.**
4. **Birds showing evidence of disease will not be accepted and entry fees will be forfeited.**
5. The superintendent or any assigned judge shall have full authority to disbar from competition any entry which is too immature, diseased, or otherwise unworthy of the breed it represents.
6. During the period of the fair, the fair will feed and water the birds.
7. All Birds exhibited **MUST** have numbered leg bands.
8. Competition is open to anyone; 4-H and FFA exhibitors may show in Public Competition as long as they show different birds than they are showing in 4-H or FFA.
9. There will be no advertising, premiums or anything else placed on the coops or in the building without the approval of the superintendent.
10. Birds will be tested for Pullorum after judging, unless NPIP or other testing papers are submitted.

Best of Breed: \$3.00

Reserve Best of Breed: \$2.00

Best of Breed awarded if there are 12 or more birds shown in the breed.

Premium money must be picked up at the fair office.

Division Champions:

Champion: \$5.00 and Rosette

Reserve Champion: \$3.00 and Rosette

Champions awarded if there are 20 or more birds judged in any of the following classes:

Large Chicken Divisions: American, Asiatic, English, Mediterranean, Continental, and all other standard breeds.

Bantam Divisions: Modern Game, Old English Game, Single Comb Clean Legged, Rose Comb Clean Legged, All Other Combs Clean Legged, Feather-Legged.

Turkeys: All compete in one division

Guineas: All compete in one division

Special Awards:

Grand and Reserve Champions in Large Chickens, Bantam Chickens, and Waterfowl receive a Rosette.

Poultry and Pigeon Staff Award: A one year membership to the Pacific Northwest Poultry Association will be awarded to outstanding youth. Awards will be determined by the superintendents.

Half dozen eggs in an egg carton required. Eggs will be judged on display, appearance, uniformity, and freshness. (One egg will be cracked open to check for freshness).
