EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The Department of Transportation and Development (DTD) received a Transportation Growth Management (TGM) grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to update the County's Pedestrian and Bicycle Transportation Plans. The awarded grant funds allowed the county to procure a consultant to assist in preparing the *Walk Bike Clackamas Plan.* To complete the scope of work and conduct additional public outreach, an amendment to the contract to extend the project timeline is needed. No general fund monies are required and there is no change in the scope of the work. The amendment would extend the contract to September of 2024.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners sign the attached Amendment No. 1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Walk Bike Clackamas Plan.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT Clackamas County, Walk Bike Clackamas Plan

This is Amendment No. 01 to the Agreement between the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "ODOT" or "Agency", and Clackamas County, hereinafter referred to as "County", entered into an intergovernmental agreement on May 20, 2022 ("Agreement"). Said Agreement covers a Transportation and Growth Management grant for Clackamas County, Walk Bike Clackamas Plan.

It has now been determined by ODOT and County that the Agreement referenced above, although remaining in full force and effect, shall be amended to extend the agreement termination date, and revise Parties contact information and Schedule in Exhibit A.

1. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Amendment shall become effective on the date it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.

2. Amendment to Agreement.

a. Section 2, Terms of Agreement, Paragraph A, which currently reads:

"<u>Term</u>. This Agreement becomes effective on the date on which all parties have signed this Agreement and all approvals (if any) required to be obtained by ODOT have been received. Further, ODOT's obligation to make any disbursements under this Agreement is subject to payment of the County's Matching Amount by County to ODOT. This Agreement terminates on January 31, 2024 ("Termination Date"), unless terminated earlier in accordance with Section 8 of this Agreement."

Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"<u>Term</u>. This Agreement becomes effective on the date on which all parties have signed this Agreement and all approvals (if any) required to be obtained by ODOT have been received. Further, ODOT's obligation to make any disbursements under this Agreement is subject to payment of the County's Matching Amount by County to ODOT. This Agreement terminates on September 30, 2024 ("Termination Date"), unless terminated earlier in accordance with Section 8 of this Agreement."
