APPROVAL OF LAST MEETING MINUTES: Approved October meeting minutes with corrections.

CALL FOR ADDITIONAL AGENDA ITEMS:

-Update on the TSC bylaws: Reviewed the revised bylaws to add:

2.5 Leave of Absence for High School Student Members: High School student members may request a leave of absence from their commission term during the summer. A member on an approved leave of absence will not be treated as having resigned from the commission, will not be counted in establishing a quorum under 4.2, and will not be entitled to vote.

CITIZEN CONCERNS:

Sight distance issues with Sunnyside and 132nd. Christian to look into seeing if this is a county road or a city and if we can make any changes.

OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS:

a) Fatality Report: October and November YTD: 2 Fatalities in October/November, (1) Vehicle and (1) Motorcycle.

- b) Review of Citizen concerns section of the agenda as standard item: If a member has a concern that would be under the additional agenda items. If a member speaks to a citizen then that would be under citizen concerns.
- c) Data on Crashes: Reviewed Christians memo that was prepared for the TSC, see attached memo. Discussion around following too close and how it relates to crashes. The data shows crash type and crash cause.
- d) ODOT Safety Conference-Jim and Bob spoke about their experience at the conference. Jim had a conversation with a member of Lane County who recently received a grant to provide education courses to businesses on distractive driving. Jim sat in on a presentation on distracted driving and heard from a different prospective from a police officer. Bob was able to have some conversations regarding tailgating with a few people at the conference. This was addressed in the general meeting- Major problem with enforcement was funding.
- e) Discussed school bus safety and how other states take enforcement School Bus stops and what equipment is used.
- f) High Friction Surface treatment: TSC is looking for an update on this.
- g) Filling a vacancy: Discussion on advertising on new members. Looking to close the advertisement on Sunday, November 25th to potentially have meetings in December. Want to reach out to citizens in rural Clackamas County.
- h) TSAP Priorities for Commission: TSAP properties were posted around the board. The members were given the option to choose 5 action items to have the TSC focus on. Refer to the TSC Reflections on the TSAP document.
