

Clackamas Parenting Together Small Grants Notice of Funding Opportunity (21-22) FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Question 1:

Are there any recommendations for parent education programs that the grant would like us to focus on?

- Exhibit A: Curriculum Library includes information on commonly used OPEC approved curricula and minimum series length.

Question 2:

Can I partner with another non-profit and/or school that also has evidence-based educational programs to deliver the educational programs we have together?

- Eligible applicants are nonprofit organizations, schools, or public entities serving residents of Clackamas County. Funding to individuals is not allowed. An eligible organization needs to submit the grant application and would be the fiscal holder of the agreement. Eligible organizations can partner with other providers for service delivery.

Question 3:

I was considering applying for the Parenting ED grant for Morrison's Parent's Anonymous groups but wasn't sure if it meets the criteria – it is EBP listed in the California Evidenced Based Clearinghouse, but it is not a curriculum based parenting class, it is a support group. Would that qualify for this funding?

- It is dependent upon what target age group you would be focusing on, there is a portion of the funding targeting parents of older children. This program may be allowable under that funding stream.
