## Appointed Boards and Commissions (ABCs) Recommendation

The Clackamas County Community Health Council, under the Health, Housing and Human Services Department, opened their recruitment for consumer and non-consumer representation. The Community Health Council has a federal grant requirement to maintain a majority of consumer members, and its by-laws require a minimum of nine members. This ABC holds a current roster of eleven members.
