



Water Environment Services (WES) Stormwater Standards may require signs to be posted to mark the locations of stormwater facilities and the boundaries of natural resource buffers. Below is one example of a Stormwater Management sign which is available for purchase from WES. Contact WES for additional information regarding stormwater signage and the other signs we have available for purchase.

**General:**

**1. Sign:**

- a. The District shall approve the design, sizing and material of the sign.
- b. Approved signs are available for purchase from the District.

**2. Location:**

- a. Stormwater Management facilities signs shall be installed on the facility fencing or permanent post where it is visible to pedestrians, or as shown on the approved plans, or as directed by the District.
- b. Natural resource buffers signs shall be installed on a fencing facing outward or permanent post where it is visible to pedestrians, or as shown on the approved plans, or as directed by the District.

**3. Installation:**

The Stormwater Management sign shall be bolted and secured to either the fence, metal posts, or pressure treated wood posts as approved by the District.
