<b>Transit Discussion: I-205 Transit Values and Discussion on Community Transit Objectives</b>	Staff shared updates that ODOT has been working to understand transit needs along the proposed I-205 toll corridor to prepare for committee recommendations on how to address transit needs. Staff has used outcomes from the October 2021 C4 Retreat to help ODOT prepare their initial drafts.  Additionally, following up on discussion from the October 2021 C4 retreat, C4 members discussed their overall transit priorities throughout the county. They have asked the Transit Advisory Committee to consider the following
