STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. The Hearings Officer for Clackamas County is:

- 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

I, Jennifer Kauppi, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

On or about the 6th day of May, 2021 the Respondents violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Respondents violated the Clackamas County Building Code, Chapter 9.02.040 by failing to obtain approved permits and approved final inspections for an addition to an accessory structure. This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

On or about the 9th day of December, 2021 the Respondents violated the following laws

in the following ways:

b. Respondents violated the Clackamas County Building Code, Chapter 9.02.040 by failing

to obtain approved permits and approved final inspections for an addition to an

accessory structure. This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas

County Violation Priorities.

On or about the 20TH day of June, 2023 the Respondents violated the following laws in

the following ways:

a. Respondents violated the Clackamas County Building Code, Chapter 9.02.040 by failing

to obtain approved permits and approved final inspections for an new accessory

structure, bath fans and a kitchen vent. This violation is a Priority 4 violation pursuant

to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the

Department of Transportation and Development.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondents in the following manner:

Administrative Citation #2100104-1 in the amount of \$100.00 was mailed via first class mail on May

Notice of the violation was given to Respondents in the following manner:

Notice of the violations was given to Respondents in the following manner:

Administrative Citation #2100104-1A in the amount of \$400.00 was mailed via first class mail on

June 20, 2023. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit J, and

incorporated by this reference.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter.

Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to

immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and

permanently enjoining Respondents from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty

against Respondents for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County

Commissioners. Said range for a Building Code Priority 1 violation being \$750.00 to \$1,000.00 per

occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code. Said range for a Building

Code Priority 4 violation being \$100.00 to \$1,000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to

the Clackamas County Code.

3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to pay

an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code;

Respondents. STATEMENT OF PROOF

History of Events and Exhibits:

March 29, 2021 Clackamas County received a complaint regarding an addition to an Exhibit A accessory structure without permits. Building Inspector Robert Fix conducted a site inspection and confirmed the violation existed.

Violation Letter was sent first class mail to the Respondents with a deadline March 29, 2021 Exhibit B of April 29, 2021 to abate the Building Code violation. The first class mail

was not returned.

May 10, 2021 A review on County records found no permits had been submitted for the Exhibit C addition to the accessory structure. Citation 2100104-1 for \$100.00 for the

Priority 1 Building Code violation was sent first class mail. The first class

mail was not returned. The citation remains unpaid.

December 9, 2021 A review on County records found no permits had been submitted for the Exhibit D

addition to the accessory structure. Citation 2100104-1 for \$500.00 for the Priority 1 Building Code violation was sent first class mail. The first class

mail was not returned. The citation remains unpaid.

December 14, 2021 Permit B0729121 was submitted for the addition to the accessory structure.

Exhibit E

May 2, 2022 Permit B0729121 was issued and received a partial approval for the exterior

Exhibit F shear wall inspection on July 29, 2022.

April 20, 2023 I reviewed County records and found permit B0729121 had expired on Exhibit G

January 29, 2023 without receiving all of the required inspections.

Correspondence was sent to the Respondent with a deadline of May 1, 2023 to renew permit B0729121 and receive all required inspections by June 5,

2023.

May 2, 2023 Exhibit H	I conducted a site inspection in order to obtain current photos of the accessory structure. It was during this inspection that I found a new accessory structure that had been built behind the existing accessory structure on site. This structure is approximately 4,280 square feet in size. While reviewing the aerial images, I found that new solar panels had been installed on the single family residence. I reviewed County records and found no permits had been submitted for the new accessory structure. Permit B0688322 was submitted to the County for the installation of solar panels on the single family residence on November 9, 2022 and was set to expire on June 12, 2023.
May 8, 2023 Exhibit I	Correspondence was sent to the Respondents with a deadline of June 13, 2023 to abate the violation for the new accessory structure and for the expired mechanical permit for the bath fans and kitchen fan venting. I let the Respondents know that the solar permit was going to expire on June 12, 2023.
June 20, 2023 Exhibit J	Building Inspector Robert Fix confirmed during a site inspection that the new accessory structure remained on the subject property. Citation 2100104-1A was issued for \$200.00 for the Priority 4 Building Code violation for the accessory structure and \$200.00 for the Priority 4 Building Code violation for the bath fans and kitchen venting that did not receive approved final inspections.
June 20, 2023 Exhibit K	Correspondence was sent to the Respondents with a deadline of July 7, 2023 to renew the solar permit and obtain the electrical permit for the solar installation.
July 25, 2023	A review of County records found that the solar permit B0688322 remained in expired status and no electrical permits had been applied for.
July 25, 2023	This matter was referred to the Hearings Officer.

I received a phone call from Serge who stated that the newly built accessory

structure had been removed. I conducted a site inspection and confirmed

that the structure had been removed from the property.

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the Building Code, Title 9.02.040 exists, the County may request a Continuing Order in this matter recommending the following:

- The Respondents be ordered to bring the property into compliance with the Building Code within 15 days of the date of the Order by renewing the following permits. B0129114 for the bathroom fans and kitchen venting, B0729121 for the addition to the accessory structure and B0688322 for the rooftop solar. Receive all required inspections including approved final inspections within 45 days of the permits being renewed.
- Code Enforcement to confirm compliance of the above item and the County will submit a Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent.
- The report may include the following recommendations:
- The imposition of civil penalties for the Building Code violation of up to \$1,000.00 for date cited May 6, 2021. The imposition of civil penalties of the Building Code violation of up to \$1,000.00 for date cited December 9, 2021. The imposition of civil penalties for the Building Code violation of up to \$2,000.00 for date cited June 20, 2023 for a total amount due of \$4,000.00.
- Payment for Citation No. 2100104-1 issued on May 10, 2021 for \$100.00.
- Payment for Citation No. 2100104-2 issued on December 9, 2021 for \$500.00
- Payment for Citation No. 2100104-1A issued on June 20, 2023 for \$400.00
- The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from March, 2021 until the violation is abated. As of this report the total is \$2,025.00
- The County requests the Hearings Officer to permanently prohibit the Respondents from violating this law in the future.
- If the Respondents fail to comply with the Hearings Officer's Continuing Order the County will request the Hearings Officer to issue a Final Order and will also request the Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.



 - o The permit must be picked up within ten days of being notified.
 - Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of the permit being issued. Or:
- Obtain a demolition permit for the structure(s).
 - o Remove all associated debris from the demolition not later than 45 days of the date of the permit.

Important Notices

- Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a
 citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement
 Compliance Hearings Officer.
- Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the
 enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a
 written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement
 Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at
 codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. Potential Fines and Penalties: The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. **Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property:** Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.





